- Goals:**
1. Members and friends of Immanuel Presbyterian Church are provided learning opportunities aimed at different levels of faith maturity so as to promote spiritual growth and involvement in ministry.
 2. The whole person – physical, intellectual, spiritual and emotional – is considered when planning educational opportunities.

Our Responsibilities:

1. In consultation with the Finance Committee and with approval of the Session the committee will budget for and execute authorized funding for educational materials, promotion and other costs.
2. Secure teachers for educational programs and submit teachers and content to the Session for approval.
3. Times and venues for educational opportunities are determined and coordinated with the person responsible for scheduling and keeping the church calendar.
4. Coordinate with the pastor and the Worship Committee on occasion to enhance seasonal observance of the Christian year and provide a variety of educational opportunities.
5. Plan and implement periodic Enquirer Classes to introduce adults new to Immanuel, to the PC(USA) and to the Reformed tradition.
6. Oversee maintenance of the church library.
7. Make a monthly report to Session including written recommendations for action.
8. Recruit sufficient committee members for efficient and effective performance of committee responsibilities.
