## CHILDREN COMMITTEE

**Our Vision:** Children and youth become disciples of Jesus Christ and learn about their place in Christ's church and how faith is translated into action.

**Goal:** All ages, nursery through high school, will have age-appropriate opportunities to learn the essential elements of Christian faith and practice.

## **Our Responsibilities:**

- 1. In consultation with the Finance Committee and with approval of the Session the committee will budget for and execute authorized funding to achieve the committee's goals.
- 2. Children and youth learn the basic stories of the Bible
- 3. Children and youth are involved regularly in worship.
- 4. Children and youth are encouraged to have meaningful conversations about faith and hard life questions.
- 5. Children and youth learn the value of serving others as a natural expression of faith.
- 6. Families are given resources to carry faith development into the home.
- 7. Intergenerational relationships in the congregation are fostered so that children and youth know older members and vice versa.
- 8. Select and/or approve materials for all children and youth programs including nursery and confirmation when called for providing guidance and suggestions.
- 9. Purchase Gift Bibles and books to mark milestones in the faith journeys of our children and youth.
- Plan and implement summer educational experiences.
- 11. Coordinate the Christmas program with the Pastor.
- 12. Support participation in R(EACH) ONE, an ecumenical ministry with youth among Nob Hill Churches.
- 13. Supervise and, in association with the Personnel Committee, review annually the work of hired staff associated with building and grounds maintenance.
- 14. Make a monthly report to Session including written recommendations for action.
- 15. Recruit sufficient committee members for efficient and effective performance of committee responsibilities.
